

## The Willingham Estate House

After the 1926 hurricane E. J. Willingham returned to Georgia. His "right-hand man", Perry Mickel and family moved into the house and stayed until they moved to their new farmhouse on the West side. The Richardsons purchased the house and land around 1937. Due to structural problems the house was demolished in the mid-1980s. It was located in what is now the parking lot adjacent to the Carriage House. All that remains from the 1920s is the stone urn-stand under the banyon tree.



The metal jalousies and screens cover unique, art-deco inward-opening casement windows found on much of the main part of the house.
