RICHARDSON HIGH FOR WILTON MANORS COUNCIL MIDDLETON SECOND

Big interest by registered voters of Wilton Manors was shown in choosing two councilment from a list of seven candidates. Out of about seven hundred percent registered to vote in wilton Manors election, 511 cast their ballet. The lovest men on the list was only 50 votes away from election to the council. If every one of the 511 voters had cast a vote for two of their choice, 1022 would be the total votes counted. The total shows 971 votes counted for the seven candidates, including 2 cast for write-ins(C Leaver and Mr. Gallup) This shows that a large number of persons voted for only one candidate. 




