
AT A SPECIAL MEETING THE PAST WEEK, WILTON MANORS CITY COUNCIL VOTED FOUR TO ONE TO VAL-IDATE AN ADDITIONAL \$190,000 OF WATER REVENUE BONDS. COUNCILMAN RICHARDSON VOTED NO. EX-PLAINING THAT HE DID NOT BELIEVE THE CITY'S NEED FOR MONEY WAS THAT GREAT, THIS AMOUNT OF ADDED BONDS WOULD MAKE THE TOTAL WATER REVENUE SONDS \$300,000. AT THE REGULAR MEET-ING PREVIOUS TO THE SPECIAL MEETING, CHAIRMAN RIGGS TURNED THE CHAIR OVER TO COUNCIL-MAN SAXER IN ORDER TO MAKE A MOTION: THAT PROCEEDINGS BE STARTED TO VALIDATE \$150,000 IN WATER REVENUE BONDS. 65,000 TO BE USED TO PAY OFF LAND DEVELOPERS FOR WATER PIPE

IN .. THEIR SUBDIVISIONS , 24,000 WAKELY MAKES SETTLEMENT DEAL FOR CITY HALL FUNDS. 11,000 FOR STREETS AND REPAIRS, AND SOLO, KEEPING SAME IN RESERVE DEVELOPERS EXCEPT ONE FOR EMERGENCY . THIS MOTION FAIL OITY SHOULD VALIDATE JUST ENOUGH BONDS FOR PRESENT NEEDS AGAINST THE CITY. AND NOT HOLD A LARGE AMOUNT IN RESERVE. 


