CITY ORDERS VALIDATION PROCEEDINGS

WATER REVENUE BONDS WILL HIT \$300,000

AT A SPECIAL MEETING THE PAST WEEK, WILTON MANORS CITY COUNCIL VOTED FOUR TO ONE TO VALIDATE AN ADDITIONAL \$190,000 OF WATER REVENUE BONDS. COUNCILMAN RICHARDSON VOTED NO, EXPLAINING THAT HE DID NOT BELIEVE THE CITY'S NEED FOR MONEY WAS THAT GREAT. THIS AMOUNT OF ADDED BONDS WOULD MAKE THE TOTAL WATER REVENUE BONDS \$300,000. AT THE REGULAR MEETING PREVIOUS TO THE SPECIAL MEETING, CHAIRMAN RIGGS TURNED THE CHAIR OVER TO COUNCILMAN SAXER IN ORDER TO MAKE A MOTION: THAT PROCEEDINGS BE STARTED TO VALIDATE \$150,000 IN WATER REVENUE BONDS. 65,000 TO BE USED TO PAY OFF LAND DEVELOPERS FOR WATER PIPE

IN THEIR SUBDIVISIONS, 24,000 FOR CITY HALL FUNDS, 11,000 FOR STREETS AND REPAIRS, AND 50,000 TO BE SET ASIDE AND NOT SOLD, KEEPING SAME IN RESERVE FOR EMERGENCY. THIS MOTION FAILED, SOME OF THE COUNCILMEN EXPRESSING AN OPINION THAT THE AMOUNT OF THE ISSUE SHOULD BE 190,000. GEO RICHARDSON PASSED EXPLAINING THAT HE FELT THE CITY SHOULD VALIDATE JUST ENOUGH BONDS FOR PRESENT NEEDS AND NOT HOLD A LARGE AMOUNT IN RESERVE, AS DOING SO WOULD MAKE SPENDING OF SAME TOO EASY. RIGGS MADE ANOTHER MOTION, THAT BOND ISSUE BE 190,000, THE FIRST 65,000 SOLD TO BE USED FOR PAYING THE LAND DEVELOPERS. FOUR CAST VOTES FOR, WITH RICHARDSON PASSING. THE SPECIAL MEETING LATER WHEN AUTHORIZATION WAS GIVEN FISCAL AGENT DURRANCE, WAS WHEN RICHARDSON VOTED NO AS A POSITIVE STAND AGAINST THE AMOUNT INVOLVED, EXPLAINING THAT HE WAS NOT AGAINST SPENDING OF MONEY FOR NEEDED THINGS, BUT FELT THAT 190,000 WAS NOT REQUIRED. HE MADE MOTION THAT A \$50,000 CEILING BE PUT ON CONSTRUCTION COST OF CITY HALL. MOTION FAILED FOR LACK OF SECOND.

WAKELY MAKES SETTLEMENT DEAL

WATER SUPT. WAKELY REPORTED THAT DURING THE PAST WEEK, ALL DEVELOPERS EXCEPT ONE HAVE AGREED TO ACCEPT FIFTY CENTS ON THE DOLLAR AS A SETTLEMENT FOR THEIR EXPENDITURES OF INSTALLING WATER PIPE IN THEIR DEVELOPMENTS, 95% OF THE MONEY VALUE INVOLVED IS IN THIS CONSIDERATION. 122,000 IN CLAIMS ARE AGAINST THE CITY.

GO AHEAD FOR CITY HALL PLANS

COUNCILMAN MIDDLETON MADE A MOTION THAT THE CITY GO AHEAD WITH PLANS TO BUILD A CITY HALL ON THE PROPERTY THAT DEVELOPERS OF MIDDLE RIVER ESTATES HAVE OFFERED AS A SITE. QUESTION OF THE LARGE COST OF A BUILDING THAT WOULD MEET THE DONORS SPECIFICATIONS WAS BROUGHT UP. AND A COUNTER-PROPOSAL WAS MADE REGARDING THE POSSIBLE PURCHASE OF THE PEDERSEN BUILDING WHICH IS LOCATED ON 26 STREET, ... FOR THE SUM OF 30,000. A HEATED DEBATE DEVELOPED IN WHICH THE AUDIENCE TOOK PART. MR. STEEL, WHO STATED THAT HE REPRESENTED THE DONORS, POINTED OUT TO THE COUNCIL THAT A LARGE POTENTIAL

AMOUNT OF REVENUE FOR THE CITY IN THE FORM OF TAXES IN THE FUTURE, WAS INVOLVED IN THE PROPERTY DUE TO IT'S GREAT VALUE AS A BUSINESS SITE, IF THE COUNCIL WOULD CONSIDER OTHER PLANS FOR A CITY HALL. THE MOTION WAS VOTED ON... FOUR FOR, RICHARDSON NO.

LOCATION OF THE BUILDING DOES NOT MATTER A GREAT DEAL TO THE EDITOR, EXCEPT FROM A BUSINESS POINT OF VIEW, AS IT AFFECTS HIS OWN BUSINESS AS A RETAIL STORE OWNER. WE BUSINESS PEOPLE WHO ARE IN THE IMMEDIATE NEIGHBORHOOD OF THE PRESENT CITY OFFICES, ARE CONVINCED THAT SAID OFFICES IN A BUSINESS DISTRICT ARE SOMETIMES DETRIMENTAL FOR BUSINESS; IN OUR CASE; THE LACK OF PARKING FACILITIES AND THE FACT THAT MUCH OF THE SPACE IS TAKEN UP BY CITY EMPLOYEES, CITY OFFICIALS, AND VISITORS TO THE CITY OFFICES, LEAVES VERY LITTLE ROOM FOR CUSTOMERS OF OUR RETAIL ESTABLISHMENTS. 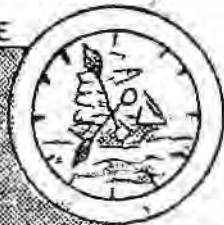
