THE FIRST DEED ON RECORD INVOLVING PRESENT WILTON MANORS
WAS EXCUTED IN 1890. IT CAME
ABOUT AS A STEP IN THE ROMANTIC STORY OF THE RECLAIMATION
OF THE MANGROVE BWAMPS AND
SAND DUNES AND THEIR TRANSFORMATION INTO THE PRESENT OREAUCOME-TRUE-LAND FOR TOURISTS
AND A MONDERFUL PLACE TO LIVE
FOR THE YEAR ROUND RESIDENTS.

THE YEAR 1881 A GROUP OF ST. AUGUSTINE PEOPLE HEADEO BY JOHN JESCOTT, INCORPATED THE LINE CANAL AND FLORIDA COAST TRANSPORTATION CO., CAPITALIZ-ED AT \$100,000 FOR THE PURPOSE "CONSTRUCTING, WAINTAINING AND OPERATING A CANAL, OR AR-TIFICAL WATERWAY FOR THE PASS-AGE OF BOATS AND VESSELS, WITH THE NECESSARY LOCKS, FOR PUB-410 USE IN THE CONVEYANCE OF AND PROPERTY, TO EX-TEND FROM SOME POINT NEAR THE HEAD OF MATANZA RIVER, IN ST. JOHNS COUNTY, SOUTHWARD TO THE HEAD IF THE HALIFAX RIVER"-A DISTANCE OF ABOUT 12 MILES. IN 1882 THE PROJECT WAS ENLARGED THE CANAL CONT. PAGE 2 TO EXTENO ALL THE

ALONG ITS "PRESENT AND PROPOSED EXTENDED LINE", AND IN 1889 ODNFIRMED THE GRANT OF LAND TO THE COMPANY, AT THE RATE OF 3.840 ACRES PER MILE FOR THE ENTIRE DISTANCE OF 320 MILES. ST. AUDUSTINE TO BISCAYNE BAY.

THE CANAL WAS TO BE 50 FEET WIDE AND 5 FEET DEEP, AT MEAN LOW WATER.

THE TRUSTEES OF THE INTERNAL IMPROVEMENT FUND OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA HAD, MEANTIME, BEEN DESIGNATED AS CUSTODIANS OF ALL SWAMP LANDS OF THE STATE. THUS IT CAME ABOUT THAT THE TRUSTEES IN 1890 IS SUED THE FIRST DEED TO LANDS IN WILTON MANORS AND OTHER LANDS. THE TOTAL WAS SOMETHING DVER A MILLION ACRES,

COLOMATCHEE AND WAS MOVED AT A LATER DATE TO OAKLAND PARK WHERE IT SOMETIME LATER BURNS ED TO THE GROUND.

COLONATOHEE NA EL INDIAN PLACE-MANE OF LOGAL ORIGIN. CURRENT BEFORE THE RAILROAD CAME. IT IS SAID THAT TILLIAM C.COLLIER WAS THE FIRST WHITE SETTLER IN THIS NORTHEAST SEC-TION NOT LONG AFTER STRANAHAN SETTIED ON NEW RIVER. HE HAD A RICH LITTLE AREA ALONG THE South side of the North Fork OF MIDDLE RIVER, EAST OF THE PRESENT RAILROAD. HE HAP AN DRANGE GROVE AND THE INCIANS DEVELOPED QUITE A FONONESS FOR HIS ORANGES. THEY CALLED HIM COLO, AND HATCHEE MEANT RIVER, HENCE THE LOCATION WAS COLOHATOHEE -- COLLIER AT RIVER.

STRANAHAN AND FRANK OLIVER WERE OWNERS OF LAND HERE IN WILTON MANORS. IN FACT, IN 1910 OLIVER, MODDY AND JEAVER PLATTED THE LAND LYING BETWEEN THE RAILROAD AND OLD DIXLE, SOUTH OF MAHANNA ROAD AND CALLED IT COLDHATCHEE.

THE OLDEST HOUSE NOW STANDING IN WILTON MANORS IS AT THE CORNER OF OLD DIXIE AND MAHANNA ROAD-(NE 24 STREET) AND IS DWNED EY C. H. HUTCHINSON

THE DLO-TIME STRUCTURE BUILT AROUND 1912 BY A MAN NAMED JOHNSON, OALLED UNCLE BILLY WHO FARMED AND KEPT A DAIRY. AS AN EXAMPLE OF HOW WELL BUILT THE HOUSE IS, THE FLOORS ARE OF THREE INCH CADE PINE. UNCLE BILLY BOUGHT HIS FARE FROM OLIVER AND SOLD OUT TO E.J. WILLINGHAM IN 1924 AND THERE BEGINS THE STORY OF WIL-TON MANORS PROPER, WILLINGHAM APPEARED ON THE SCENS IN THIS COMMUNITY AS THE DEVELOPER CF LAUDEROALE BEACH

AFTER HAVING THAT WELL UNDER-WAY, HE ACQUIRED THE GROUND HERE AND PLATTED WILTON MANDRS UNIT NUMBER 1 IN 1925.

THE PLAT OF UNIT NO. 1 SHOW-ED, BUT DID NOT INCLUDE THE LAND LYING ALONG THE NORTH-SIDE OF THE SDUTH FORK OF MIDDLE RIVER, ALTHOUGH IT APPARENTLY WAS DWNED BY WILLENGHAM. HE RESIDED IN THE PRESENT RICHARDSON HOUSE, HAVING REMODELED A SMALLER ONE ON THE SITE INTO THE PRESENT COMMODELED RESIDENCE.

FROM PRESENT LAZY LAKE CAME
ROCK FOR CONSTRUCTION. WILTON
MANORS WAS AN AMBITICUS PROJECT FOR A HIGH GRADE CUEDI+
VISION. WILTON DRIVE. 90 TOET

RESIDENTAL DISTRICT. EMPHASIS WAS PLACED UPON THE NORTHEAST GORNER AT THE INTERSECTION DE THE DRIVE AND OLD DIXIEL BLOCK 694, ABUAGENT TO THE FEC RR. WAS RESERVED FOR BUSINESS TO BE IMPROVED WITH TWO BTORY BUILDINGS DNLY. SIDEWALKS ON OLD DIXIE WERE 10 FEET WIDE. THE INTRANCE TO THE RESIDENCE DISTRICT WAS MADE IMPRESSIVE WITH TWO CRENULATED TOWERS. BUT THEY WERE NOT JUST FALSE FRONTS OF STUCCO ON LATHE AS WERE MANY SIMILAR STRUCTURES WHICH DECAYED AND FELL APART IN SUCCEEDING YEARS TO BECOME AS MANY SUCH DID, OASTLY RE-MINDERS OF CISAPPOINTED HOPES AND LOST INVESTMENTS. THESE TOWERS WERE BUILT FOR KEEPS AND STILL STAND TODAY AS WELL AS WHEN ERECTED, WITHOUT CRACK OR SETTLEMENT. THEY HAD CONCRETE FOUNDATION AND BELT OOURSES AT EACH STORY WITH STEEL REINFORDEMENT AS THOUGH BUILT UNDER PRESENT DAY BUILD-ING CODE. THEY WERE, AND STILL ARE, BEAUTIFUL WITH DE-CORATIVE INSERTS OF COQUINA ROCK. AND AFTER THE FASHION OF THE FAMOUS ARCHITECT, ADD-ISON MIZNER, WERE GIVEN FACE RELIEF. BETWEEN THE TOWERS A CABLE WAS STRUNG TO DISPLAY A WELCOME TO VILTON MANORS" BAN-NER. THE SOUTH TOWER HAD STAIR-WAYS TO THE UPPER FLOORS AND WAS USED TO TAKE PROSPECTIVE PURCHASERS TO THE TOP AND SHOW THEM THE AREA. THIS TOW-ER AND THE BLOCK ON WHICH IT STANDS WERE ACQUIRED YEARS AGO BY M.D. MACE. AFTER COMPLETION OF HIS OWN HAND-SOME RESIDENCE THE TOWER WITH ADDITIONS WAS CONVERTED INTO AN UNIQUE AND CONVENIENT RE-SIDENCE WHILE STILL PRESERV-ING THE ORIOINAL DESIGN.

IT IS SAID THAT THE NAME WIL-TON WAS SELECTED TO PERPETUATE A BRANCH OF THE WILLINGHAM ANCESTRY IN ENGLAND, OF WHICH HE WAS VERY PROUD AND IN OR-DER TO SE A CREDIT TO THAT NAME THE MANORS WAS RESTRIO-TEO TO CAUCASIANS AND THE 14-PROVEMENTS WERE TO BE OF NON-COMBUSTIBLE MATERIALS. RESI-DENTE ON THE DRIVE WERE. TO COST NOT LESS THAN \$8,500, ON DIXIE HIGHWAY \$7,000, AND ALL OTHERS IN PROPORTION. INGIAN NAMES WERE GIVEN TO ALL STR-EETS EXCEPT THE PRESENT 26 ST WHICH WAS CALLED PROSPECT THE RESTRICTIONS WERE TO RUN FOR 20 YEARS OR UNTIL 1944. LOTS WERE SOLD FOR HIGH PRICES. WILTON MANORS A PLACE OF DIS-TINTION AS A SELEC'S LOCALITY. AND TO AUGMENT HIS CONSIDER+ ABLE CAPITAL. THEN, SUDDENLY DISASTER CAME IN THE FORM OF THE 126 HURRICANE, ALL ACTIV-ITY CEASED, HERE AND EVERY-WHERE IN FLORIDA. MAINLY: DAVE TURNER, ALVAR HAGEN, JOHN PEDERSEN. AND PERRY MICKEL.

DAVE TURNER, FIRST MAYOR OF WILTON MANORS, IS A FLORIDIAN, HAVING BEEN BORN IN JT. AUGUS-TINE. HE DAME TO POMPANO AREA IN 1906, AND MOVED TO FT. LAUDERDALE IN 1912. ABOUT 12 YEARS AGO HE AND FAMILY MOVED TO WILTON MANORS. IN 1943, ON EXPIRA-TION OF THE ORIGINAL DEED RE-STRICTIONS MR. TURNER BOUGHT OUT THE WILLINGHAM ESTATE HOLDINGS. HE HAD IT RESURVEY-ED ANO BEGAN TO MARKET THE LOTS AT A REASONABLE PRICE, AND SOON DISPOSED OF THEM. IN THE LAST FEW YEARS HE HAS; IN AN ASSOCIATION WITH JAMES DEAN AND OTHERS, PLOTTED A LARGE TRACK OF LAND EAST OF THE FEC RR. LYING SETWEEN N.E. 26TH STREET AND NORTH FORK OF MIDDLE RIVER, WHICH IS BEING SOLO AS MIDDLE RIVER ESTATES. MR. TURNER DONATED THE LAND TO THE CITY ON WHICH THE VIL-LAGE HALL IS BUILT.

ALVAR HAGEN CAUE UPON THE SCENE IN '40 FROM BERWYN, ILL. HE ACQUIRED PROPERTY ADJACENT TO THE RICHARDSON GOLF COURSE AND ALONG THE SOUTH SANK OF MIDDLE RIVER, A N D SOME ON THE SOUTH END OF THE DRIVE. HE SULLT AND SOLD RESIDENCES. BUILT IMPORTANT BUSINESS HOUSES ALONG BILTON DRIVE.

HE WAS ONE OF THE MAIN PERSONS RESPONSIBLE FOR STARTING THE WILTON MANORS CIVIC ASS'N MR. HAGEN RECENTLY DONATED A 100 x 500 PIECE OF GROUND FOR USE AS A CITY PARK.

THE SAME TIME AS HADEN AND ADQUIRED OF SAME TIME AS HADEN AND ADQUIRED OF SAME THROUGH PURCHASE OF TAX PROPERTY, WHICH NE SOLD AT A REASONABLE PRICE. COURTEOUSLY REFERRED TO AS MISS US MAUDE BY OLO TIMERS IN THE COUNTY, HAS LIVEO I N VILTON MANORS CONTINUOUS LY SINCE 1910 AT THE SAME SITE, MAKING HER WITHOUT DOUBT, THE LONGEST LIVING RESIDENT OF THE COMMUNITY. MISS'US MAUDE RAISEO THREE SOYS, GUY, GEO., AND KEN-NETH. GUY AND KENNETH LIVE IN WILTON MANORS, AND GUY IS PROBABLY THE OLDEST LIVING PERSON BORN WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY, HAVING BEEN BORN IN 1915. THE SMITHS DAN RIGHT-FULLY BE CALLED A PIONEER FAM-ILY.

BILL ROBINSON DOUBLED IN HIS DUTIES AS COUN-CILMAN BY ACTING ALSO AS THE FIRST ATTORNEY OF THE VILLAGE
