THIS NEWS ITEM WAS NOT SIGNED BY A REPORTER OR CORRESPONDENT. WE DO NOT KNOW WHERE THE INFORMATION IN THE STORY CAME FROM, BUT WE FEEL THE ITEM DOES NOT PRESENT AN EXACT PICTURE OF EXISTING CONDITIONS IN WILTON MANORS. IN FACT, THE STORY IS WRITTEN IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO REFLECT ON THE ACTUAL DESIRABILITY OF THE WILTON MANORS COMMUNITY. IT CERTAINLY ISN'T WRITTEN IN A MANNER WHICH WOULD ENHANCE THE VALUES OF PROPERTY IN THE COMMUNITY.

THE EDITOR OF THE WILTON SUNRISE NEWS TAKES EXCEPTION TO THE STORY IN ITS ENTIRETY, PARTICULARLY TO THAT PART WHICH READ, 'WILTON MANORS THUS RETAINS ITS ENVIED POSITION AS THE 'CITY WITH NO TAXES.' IT ALSO RETAINS ITS POSITION AS THE CITY WITH NO MONEY AND NO CITY HALL.'

FIRE CONSUMED NOT ONLY THEIR HOUSE, BUT ALSO A HOUSE TRAILER ON THE PREMISES, A BRAND NEW AUTOMOBILE, AND ABOUT \$200 WORTH OF NEW CLOTHING THAT HAD NOT EVEN BEEN UN-

ON TUESDAY, AUGUST 9TH, MR. DEAN WITHDREW HIS COMPANY'S OFFER TO DONATE A BUILDING SITE FOR A WILTON MANORS CITY HALL. THIS WAS FIRST MADE PUBLIC AT A SERVICE CLUB MEETING ON THAT SAME EVENING, AND THE WILTON SUNRISE NEWS CARRIED THE STORY IN ITS ISSUE OF AUGUST 11TH.

2) TO QUOTE FROM THE FT. LAUDERDALE NEWS STORY: "DURING THE PAST TWO YEARS, THE CITY HAS MADE SEVERAL ATTEMPTS TO RAISE MONEY FOR A NEW CITY HALL, BUT IN EACH CASE RESIDENTS HAVE VOTED AGAINST ANY TAX LEVIES." THIS GIVES THE IMPRESSION THAT THE VOTERS OF WILTON MANORS HAVE VOTED AGAINST TAXES SEVERAL TIMES IN THE PAST TWO YEARS. THE FACT IS THAT ONE REFERENDUM HAS BEEN HELD IN THE CITY ON AD VALOREM TAXES, AT A SPECIAL ELECTION WHICH TOOK PLACE ON SEPTEMBER 28, 1954. 186 VOTED AGAINST THE PROPOSED TAX AND 135 VOTED FOR IT. THIS CLOSE VOTE INDICATES THAT IT COULD CONCEIVABLY HAVE GONE THE OTHER WAY, HAD THE PUBLIC BEEN PROPERLY INFORMED. ALTHOUGH THE QUESTION OF THE COUNCIL'S IMPOSING A UTILITY TAX ON CONSUMERS HAS COME UP TWO

TIMES, NO VOTE HAS BEEN TAKEN ON THE PROPOSAL. THE PUBLIC HAS HAD THE OPPORTUNITY TO EXPRESS THEIR VIEWS ON THESE TWO OCCASIONS, AND THE COUNCIL IS TO BE COMMENDED FOR HEEDING PUBLIC OPINION.

A CONSENSUS OF OPINION AMONG THE CITIZENS OF WILTON MANORS SHOWS THAT THEY WERE NOT AGAINST A CITY HALL BEING BUILT, NEITHER WERE TOO MANY AGAINST THE LOCATION OF THE SITE THAT MIDDLE RIVER DEVELOPMENT CO. PROPOSED TO DONATE, BUT THEY WERE AGAINST THE EXPENDITURE OF AROUND \$100,000.00 FOR SUCH A STRUCTURE, BASED ON AN ESTIMATE OF \$84,000.00 PLUS \$4,000 FEE, AND NOT INCLUDING THE COST OF PARKING FACILITIES, LANDSCAPING, EQUIPMENT, AND FIXTURES.

3) IN REGARD TO THE STATEMENT "IT (WILTON MANORS) ALSO RETAINS ITS POSITION AS THE CITY WITH NO MONEY AND NO CITY HALL.":

ALSO THE WATER DEPT. DEBT TO THE CITY WHICH CAN BE PAID WHEN THE PROPOSED EXTENSION OF THE WATER BOND ISSUE COMES

ABOUT (THIS IS UNDER WAY NOW) WHICH AMOUNTS TO \$24,000.

\*(INDICATIONS IN STATEMENT ARE THAT FRANCHISE MONEY IS CARRIED IN A SPECIAL WATER DEPT. RESERVE SINKING FUND.)

THE WATER DEPT. STATEMENT REFLECTS THAT THE WATER DEPARTMENT IS IN GOOD FINANCIAL POSITION.

SINCE THE FIRST OF THE YEAR THE FUNDS DEPOSITED IN GENERAL FUND ACCOUNT HAVE, MONTH BY MONTH, DECREASED FROM \$28,148.79 ON JAN. 1ST, 1955, TO \$16,492.37 ON JULY 31. HOWEVER, DURING THIS TIME \$4,000 WAS SPENT TO BUILD A RECREATION SHELTER AT HAGEN PARK, \$1,100 FOR TENNIS COURTS AT THE SAME LOCATION, A NEW AUTOMOBILE BOUGHT FOR CITY USE, AND \$2,063.25 SPENT DURING THE PAST FOUR MONTHS FOR REPAIRS OF STREETS AND ROADS. A FULL-TIME DIRECTOR OF RECREATION IS BEING CARRIED AT \$100 A WEEK.

CITY OFFICES ARE BEING RENTED FOR \$75.00 PER MONTH, AT 2197 WILTON DRIVE. THE OFFICES ARE USED BY CHIEF OF POLICE FOR DEPARTMENT USE, TWO FULL-TIME CLERKS WORKING FOR THE WATER DEPT., THE WATER DEPT. SUPERINTENDENT, AND THE BUILDING INSPECTOR.
