DO UNTO OTHERS....

The Improvement Associations of Fort Lauderdale, and if we remember rightly, the North Lauderdale Improvement Association in particular, went all out in protesting Fort Lauderdale's becoming part of greater Miami insofar as trade figures are concerned and protested vigorously because the wishes of the citizens of the city were not taken into consideration. Yet, the same group of people asked the Ft. Lauderdale commissioners to extend the North boundaries of the city to take in Wilton Manors, without asking Wilton Manors people their desire.

Commissioners Doug Lockhart and Robert A. Childers are to be commended for immediately bringing to attention the fact that people affected by annexation would have to approve before they would give the proposed consideration.

At this writing, we are not concerned about the right or wrong of annexation, but about the lack of consideration for those most immediately affected.

We feel the North Lauderdale Improvement Association has plenty of problems in their own area to solve, without attempting to bring about extention of city boundries, and we fail to find any benefit annexation of Wilton Manors could give to members of their organization.

We would also like to point out that the Improvement group did not talk annexation of Wilton Manors when they went before the Fort Lauderdale commission, but called for extension of boundry lines to certain points, thus news items about this important question were not designed to draw the attention of Wilton Manors citizens.

As to the newly reorganized Riverside Improvement Association endorsing the proposal, we feel they have less consideration in the matter of the North boundaries, by reason of being on the extreme Southwest side of Fort Lauderdale.

Wilton Manors has improvement associations and other civic organizations (fifteen) who will probably have something to say about annexation.
