## Wilton Manors Recreation Board Dissolved

STARLING TO HEAD 3-MAN BOARD

Wilton Manors Council on March 22, 1956, voted to disband the 14 member Recreation Board and replace it with a two man board to be appointed by the Council and headed by Mayor Starling.

The action was the re-

sult of complaints to the council March 20, about the manner in which the Recreation Director has been handling activities.

Although the complaints pointed out to the Council that they had no criticism against the

Recreation Board, and the council agreed there was none, due to the fact that the board had no authority, appointment of a committee was made by the council to hold a hearing about the duties of the Board. Results of that meeting was disbandment of the Board.

### COMMISSION HEARS COUNTY FIRE FIGHTERS

Representatives of the County Commission met with Volunteer Fire Fighters at Deerfield March 26, 1956.

Volunteer Fire Departments ask for more funds as compensation for taking care of unincorporated areas in the County. At present the 10 departments get \$500.00 each, per year.

Chief Wakely of Wilton Manors said their Department was fighting 10 County fires to one City fire.

Commissioner Gallion stated that nothing could be done until State Legislature meets in '57.

This racket shows up every year. It's here again from reports coming to our attention. Persons who claim to be experts in the care of lawns, advise that your lawn is in great need of fertilizer or top dressing. The product they sell is worthless being nothing more than muck or peat, for which they charge exorbitant prices.

Their usual procedure is to buy a few bales of peat, moisten it to the extent where it will expand many times its dried size and then sell it to the buyer at about 2000% profit.

Another stunt to watch for, is the fellow who talks to you about buying, while his helper begins to unload and spread the material. Seldom are they turned away without being paid even if you had no desire to buy.

When approached by any peddler or solicitor at your home, ask to see their permit. If you doubt the product they are selling, call the City Offices and find out if the product is O. K. City government should know before issuing a permit, whether the peddler is legitimate.

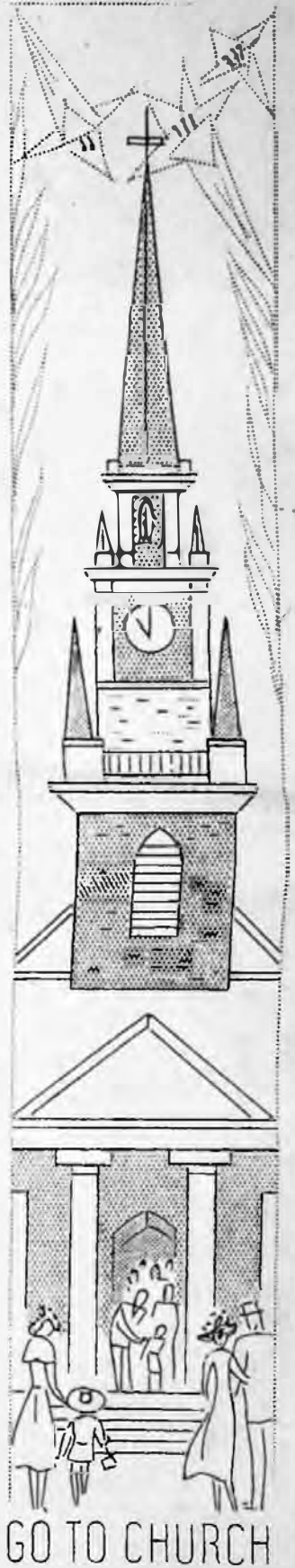

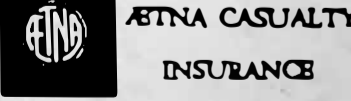
